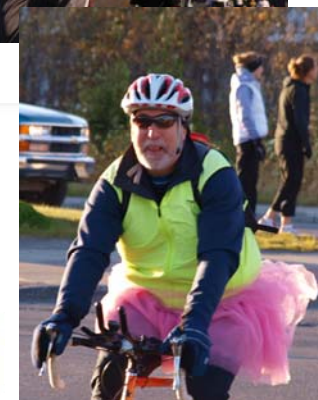
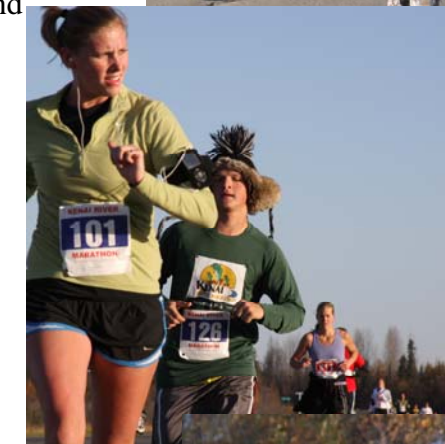
# The Best Marathon in Kenai
